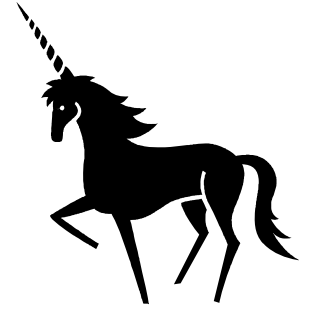


Events in Murray Street - January 2010
